How do I use this program?

What does the program offer?

- Access to a team of cancer experts who guide you through your care
- Confirmation that you are receiving the most effective treatment for your diagnosis
- Identification of commonly misstaged and/or misdiagnosed cancers
- Access to national Centers of Excellence for complex surgeries, care, and second opinions
- Assistance in finding financial and community support

What happens when I call?

- An Intake Specialist will provide information about the program and walk you through registration.
- Your CancerCARE Nurse will be available to answer questions and support you.
- You will be given information on how to ensure you receive the most appropriate evidence-based treatment for your diagnosis
- You will be provided educational materials and directed to online resources
- You will have access to the CancerCARE program throughout your cancer treatment for as long as you are eligible through your health plan.
